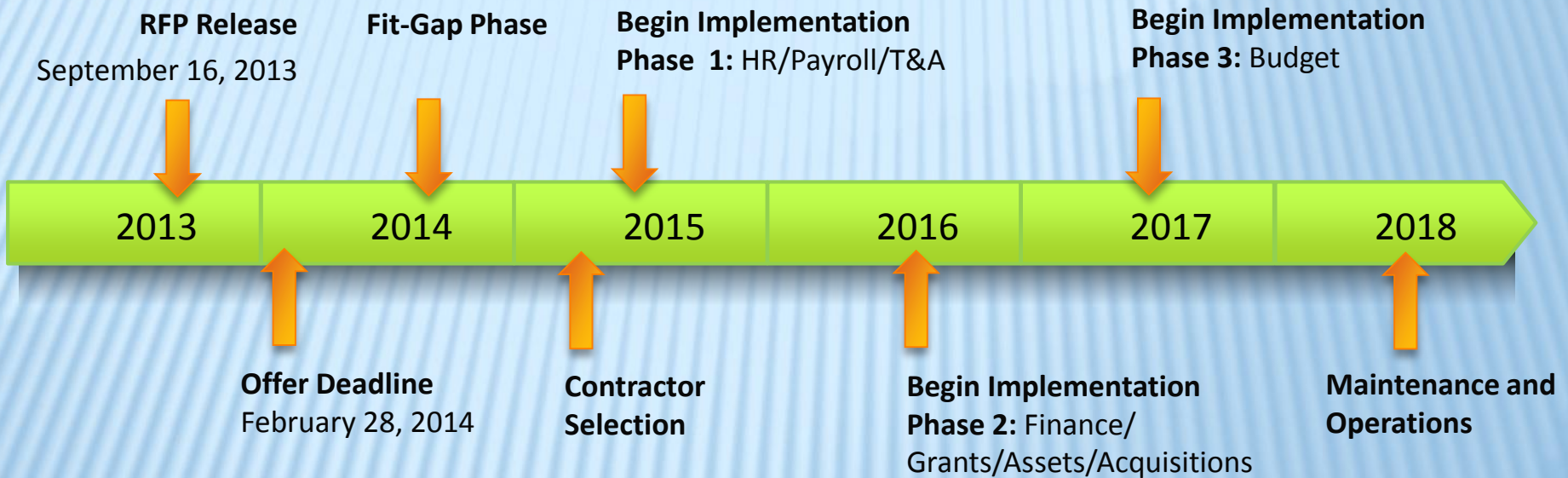
ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING (ERP) UPDATE

WHAT IS ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING?

- Single system - Integrates State's functions, data, and processes.
- Streamline and standardize business operations.
- Serves to continually value the work, commitment and dedication of our employees by providing enhanced tools and systems.

WHAT IS FIT-GAP?

- ✘ Period when planning, initial analysis and design occurs.
- ✘ Vendors try to understand whether their solution is a fit or a gap.



Fit: Meets the requirement “out of the box” with little or no changes.



Gap: Requires coding or customization to meet the requirement.

- ✘ Purpose: To help vendors understand State’s needs and the level of effort required to implement their solution.

OTHER ERP PROJECTS

- ✘ Uniform Chart of Accounts
 - + To standardize and update a statewide uniform chart of accounts (i.e. accounting codes and structure). RFP Released: January 17, 2014
- ✘ Interim Grants (iFAMS)
 - ✘ To improve the State's ability to manage and consistently report on federal awards.
- ✘ Interim Budget
 - + On Hold
- ✘ Interim Assets
 - + To coordinate an inventory of public buildings, facilities, and sites on public trust lands.
 - + Currently in planning stage.
- ✘ DLIR System Stabilization
 - + To support the DLIR Disability Compensation Division in an effort to stabilize legacy systems from failure.
- ✘ DLIR Workers Compensation
