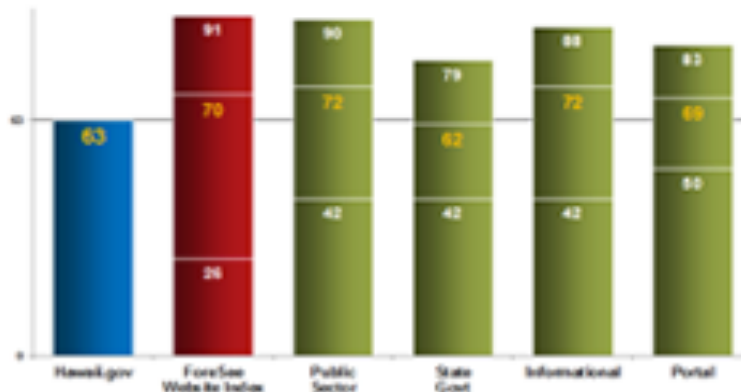

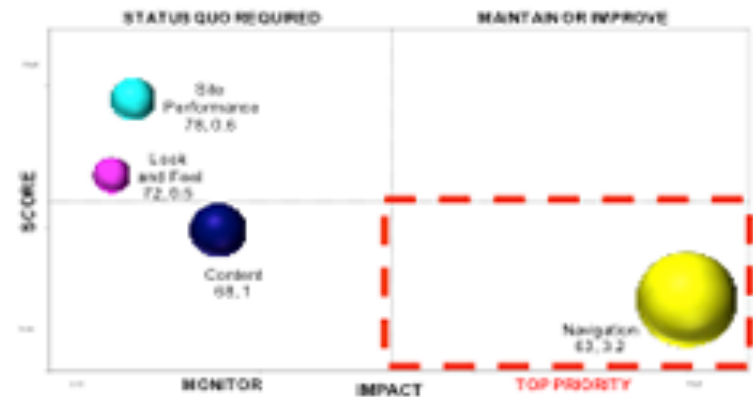

In support of the Administration's goal of creating an unprecedented level of openness in state government and the New Day Plan's objective to improve transparency and rebuild confidence in government, Chief Information Officer Sanjeev "Sonny" Bhagowalia and the Office of Information Management and Technology (OIMT) is launching the Open Data Initiative through a new online platform, data.hawaii.gov, that is scheduled to go live on **July 31, 2012**.

Data.Hawaii.Gov

Data.hawaii.gov establishes a one-stop destination for all approved State data. This new ease of access will help residents make better use of information and will lead to innovation in government and business. The launch of data.hawaii.gov is a milestone for restoring public trust in government and building a technology infrastructure that fosters meaningful citizen engagement and collaboration.

For example, providing public data could result in new websites and smartphone applications that would create value for Hawai'i's citizens, connecting them to public services in real-time. These datasets could also support cutting-edge research coming out of Hawai'i's universities and research institutions. Competitions using the data might help tackle some of Hawai'i's public challenges in innovative ways and at minimal cost to the State.

In addition to its congruence with the New Day Plan, data.hawaii.gov aligns with key principles of the State's Business and IT/IRM Transformation Plan currently under development by OIMT. Specifically, the platform will enhance the State's return on investment in collecting and managing this data by providing an environment that transcends agency silos, facilitates search capabilities, and encourages collaboration and data sharing across government.

The State of Hawaii launched its Open Data Initiative in June 2012 with support from Governor Abercrombie.

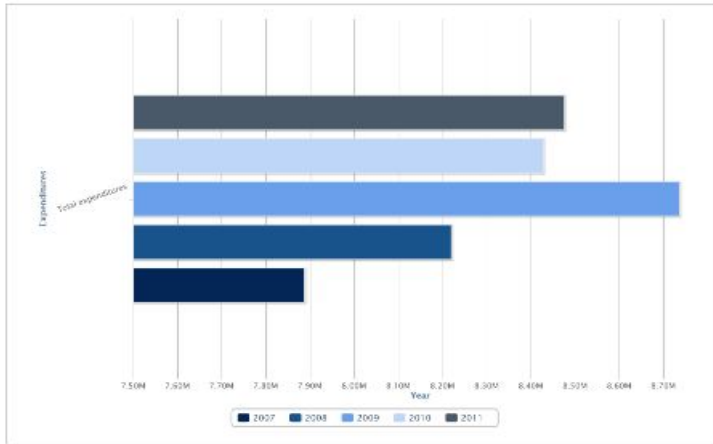

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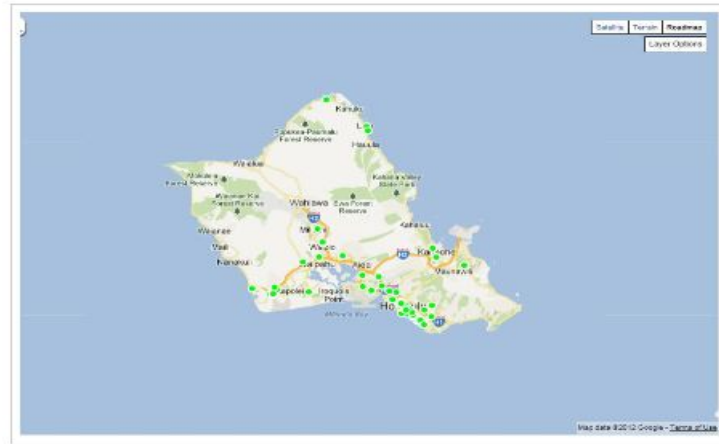
Total Government Expenditures 2007-2011 in thousands

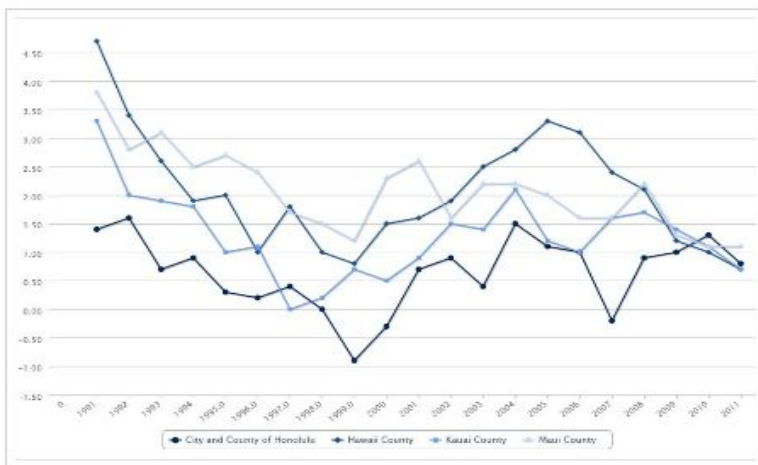

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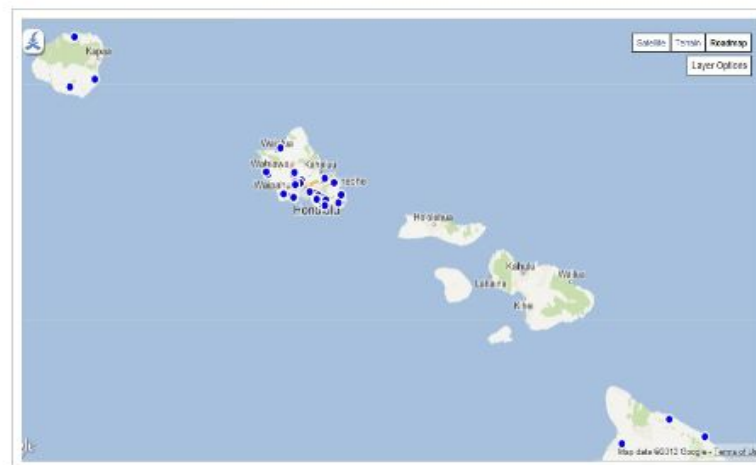
Percentage Population Change by County 1991 - 2011

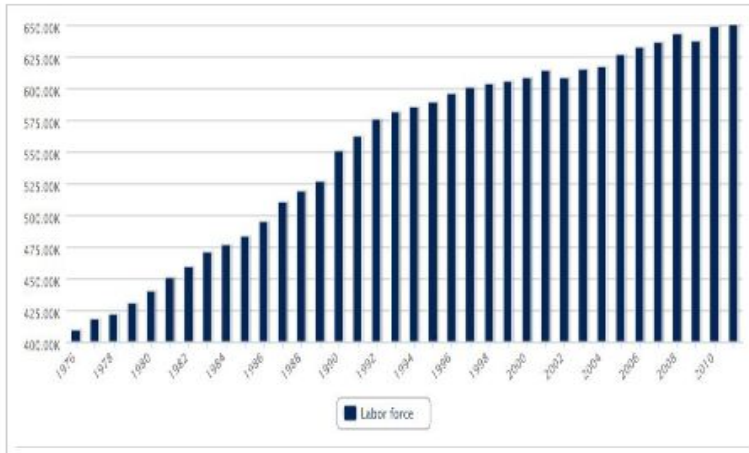

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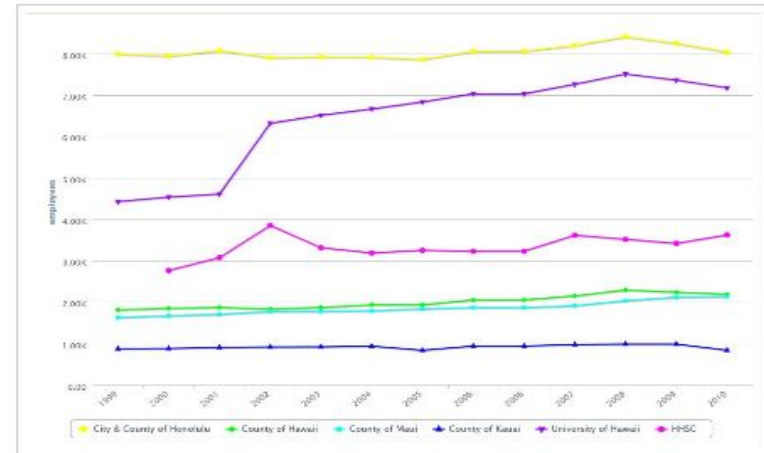
Hawaii Labor Force 1976-2011

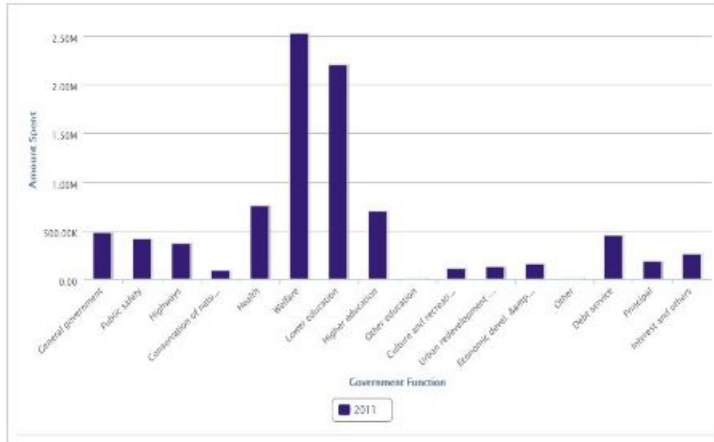

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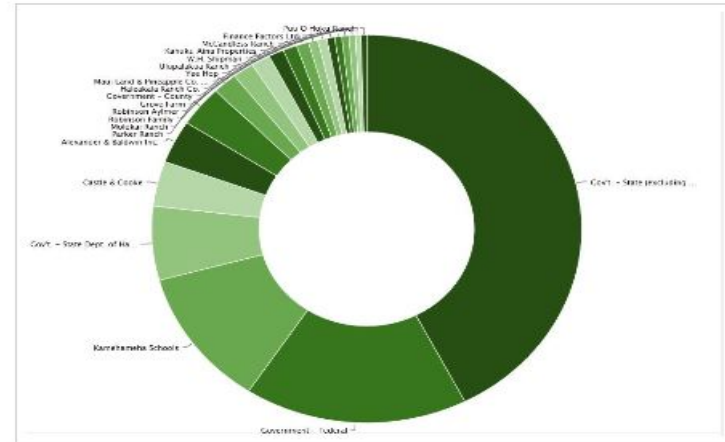
State Government Expenditures 2011 by Function

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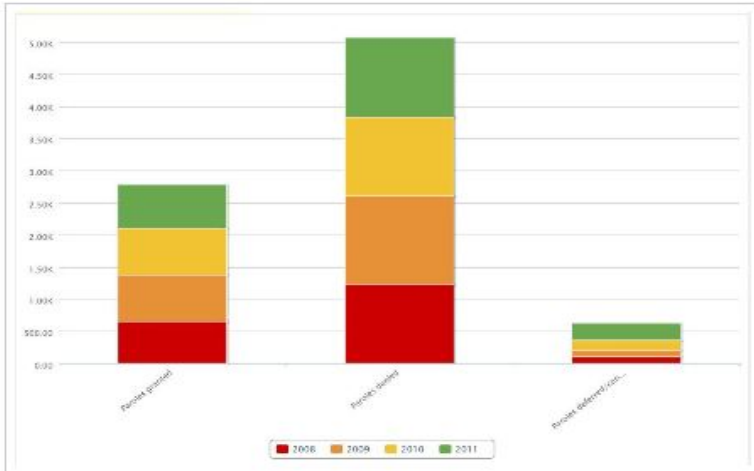


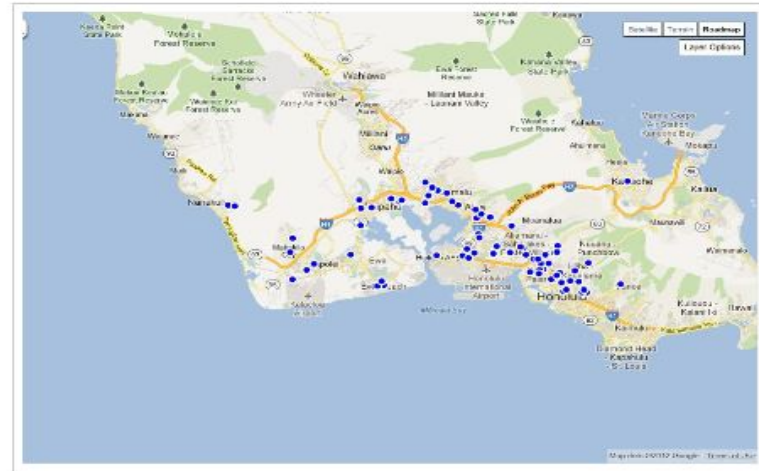
Chart of Paroles granted, denied or deferred

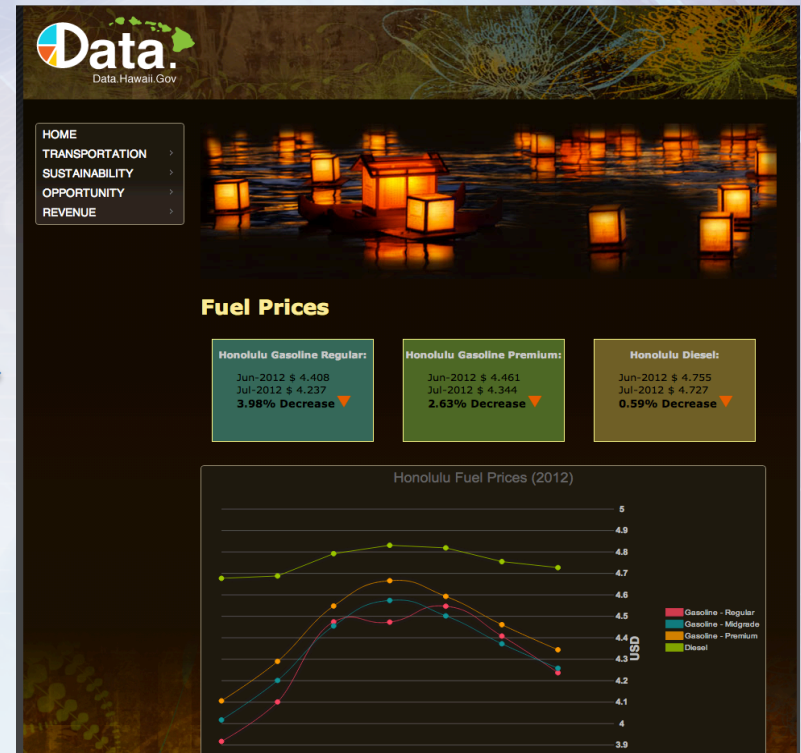

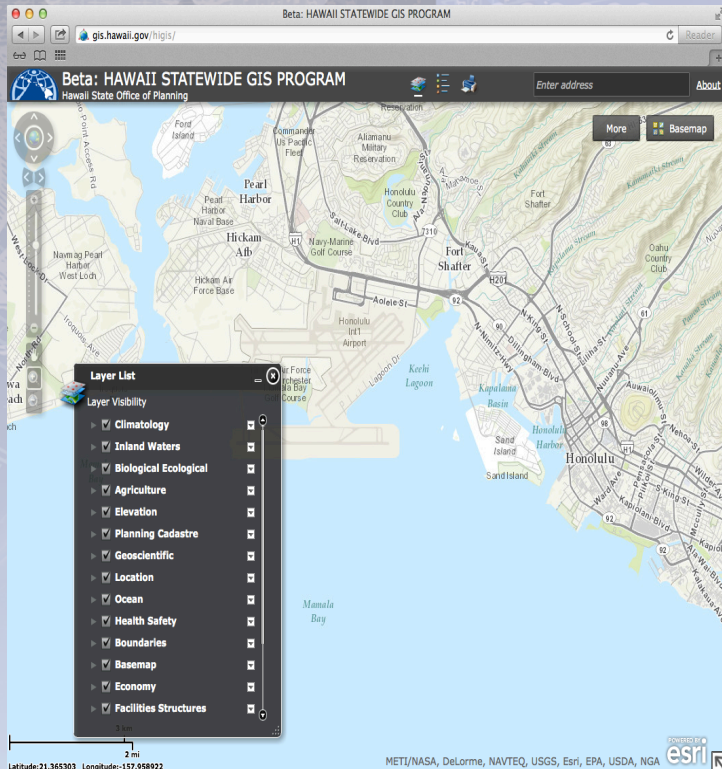

Utah	(April 2012) Department of Health: 780k Medicaid patients personally identifiable information stolen/hacked. A recent study estimates that the average cost of breaches involving less than 100,000 records is \$194 per capita, including costs of detecting and reporting the breach, notifying and assisting consumers, and opportunity costs such as turnover of existing customers. This equates to approximately \$20 million per incident. (Source: Law360)

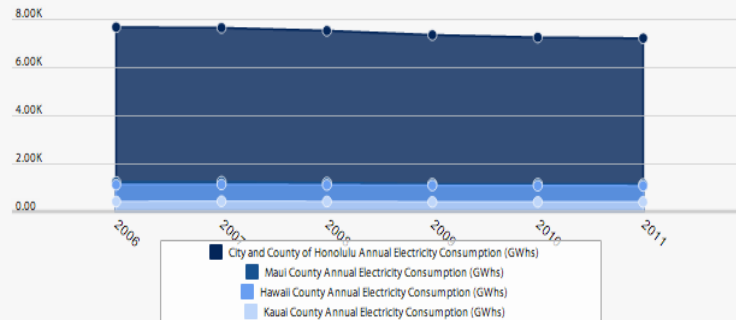

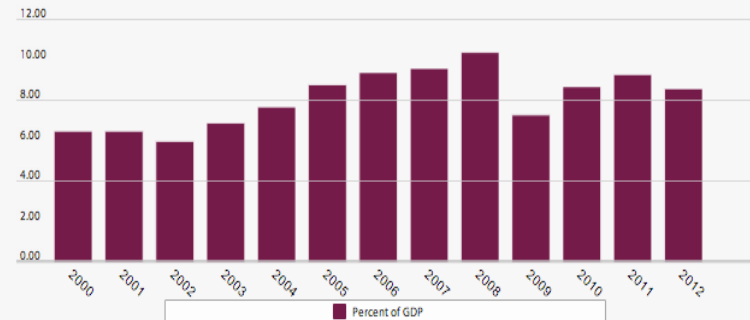
