Act 58, SLH 2016

Amended HRS §27-43 providing new authority for the CIO to:

"Work with each executive branch department and agency to develop and maintain its respective multiyear information technology strategic and tactical plans and road maps that are part of the State's overall information technology strategic plans, road maps, and directions" "Coordinate each executive branch department and agency's information technology budget request, forecast, and procurement purchase to ensure compliance with the department or agency's **strategic plan and road map** and with the office of enterprise technology services' information technology governance processes and enterprise architecture policies and standards, including policies and standards for systems, services, hardware, software, and security management"

Implementation

Memo to all Department Heads from Director of Finance and CIO (August 11, 2017):

"All department IT Roadmaps and IT budget requests shall be submitted to the CIO as part of the budget submission and review process in compliance with Administrative Directive No. 15-02, dated December 10, 2015, and Act 58, SLH 2016, Section 3 (Sections 27-43(a)(4) and (5), HRS)."

ETS conducting a preliminary review of the IT budget items departments may be considering for the FY19 Supplemental Budget request

Timeline

- July 2017
 - ETS initiated outreach to assist departments with IT roadmaps
 - SharpCloud identified as platform; two seats provided for each department
- September 2017
 - Target for submittal of all departmental IT roadmaps
- December 1, 2017
 - ITSC metric deadline
- Mid-December 2017
 - Governor submits FY19 Supplemental Budget request to the Legislature
