










User Guide

Step 3	Take a picture of your COVID-19 vaccination document.

<p>Step 5</p>	<p>Select “Create or View Hawaii SMART Health Card” (see section highlighted in screenshot).</p>	 <p> Hawaii SMART Health Card</p> <p>HOW TO OBTAIN YOUR DIGITAL HAWAII SMART HEALTH CARD</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fully vaccinated individuals who received vaccination in the State of Hawaii are eligible for the Hawaii SMART Health Card. The Hawaii SMART Health Card is for use at Hawaii restaurants and other venues accepting the SMART Health Card as digital proof of vaccination. SMART Health Cards are also accepted at venues in some other states. Eligibility begins no sooner than the 15th day after your final vaccination dose. Individuals must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select the name of the individual who will be associated with the SMART Health Card (should be legal first and last name) If you are a parent or guardian and have multiple vaccine records associated with a single email address, enter each digital vaccine record request separately. From the dropdown list, select the type of vaccine administered Enter in your dose date(s) Enter in your lot number(s) Click “Submit” (this submit button will not engage until you have completed all the required fields) Not to be used for travel purposes. If you are traveling to Hawaii, use the Apply for Exemption/Exception from Quarantine section of Safe Travels. <p>Note: If your vaccine information cannot be auto-verified by the SMART Health Card application, simply show your hard copy vaccination document or photo of vaccination document to the business. 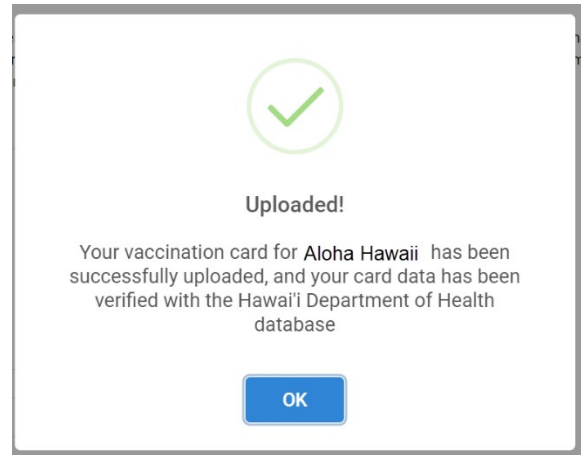

The “Submit” button will remain grayed out until all 3 fields are completed and “Accept Signature” is clicked. <p>Step 8</p>	<p>If you are a parent or guardian and have vaccine records for your minor(s), you must upload each vaccine record request for a Hawaii SMART Health Card separately.</p>

<p>Step 9a</p>	<p>You will need to complete and sign the “Authorization to Release and Disclose COVID Vaccination Information” for the minor by selecting “Yes” after the question, “Are you signing on behalf of a minor, incapacitated adult or as an attorney-in-fact?”</p> <p>“Name of Provider,” “Location,” “Name,” one of the checkboxes for “Parent or Guardian” or “Attorney-in-Fact” must be checked and the signature are required fields. 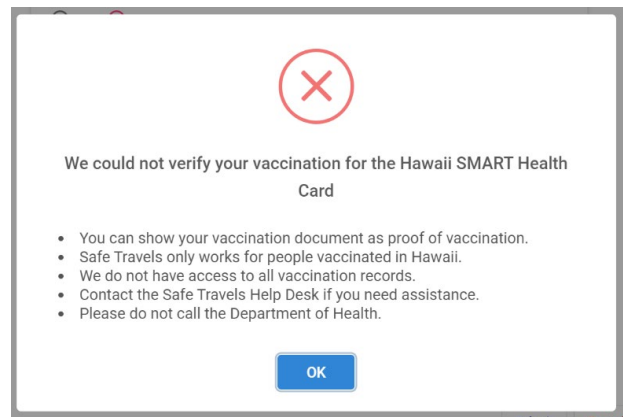
Step 10

Once you click "Submit" you will receive one of three pop-up messages.

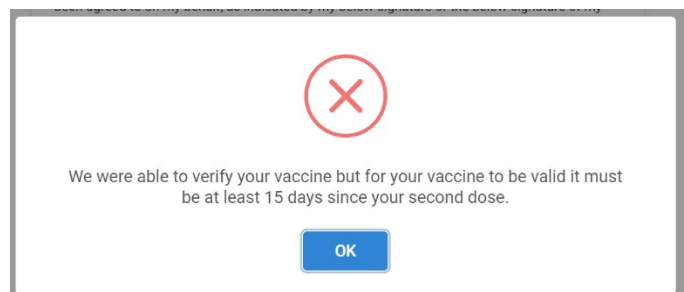
- a. If your vaccination could be verified via the State of Hawaii vaccination database.



- b. If your vaccination record could not be verified via the State of Hawaii vaccination database.



- c. If your vaccination record could be found, but you are not fully vaccinated because it has not been 15+ days since you received your final vaccination dose.





Step 11

Once validated by the system, a QR code will be generated for you to show businesses and establishments. Your Hawaii SMART Health Card QR Code will be available for display in the Hawaii SMART Health Card area of the platform.

You can simply show the Hawaii SMART Health Card QR code as proof of vaccination with "Vaccination Verified," that includes the State of Hawaii seal (see screenshot) along with your picture ID.

If you wish to make your SMART Health Card QR code larger for a business/establishment to scan, simply click directly on the SMART Health Card QR and it will enlarge.

<p>Step 13</p>	<p>Once the business or establishment scans your Hawaii SMART Health Card QR code, it will display your vaccination information. To reveal your date of birth (which is by default masked/hidden to protect your privacy and security), you must click the “eye” (see icon in yellow circle in screenshot). It will reveal the person’s date of birth for the business to verify against an acceptable identification.</p>
